Coach Information



- FACILITIES:** Wallace Wade Stadium **newly resurfaced** in 2003, ¼” spikes or pin spikes recommended for running and jumping events. Shot, hammer and discus circles are concrete. UCS starting blocks will be provided and must be used.
- DIRECTIONS:** Please go online to <http://goduke.ocsn.com/facilities/wallace-wade.html> to download directions to Wallace Wade Stadium.
- PARKING:** All buses are to park in the blue zone (traveling east on Cameron Blvd., take left on Duke University Road, take left on Wannamaker Drive and the blue zone will be located on the left hand side next to Wallace Wade Stadium). Vans can park either in the blue zone (detailed above) or in the green zone. Green zone includes parking spots along Frank Basset Drive (traveling east on Cameron Blvd., take left on Science Drive and immediate left on Frank Basset Drive). - ELIGIBILITY:** Open men’s and women’s competition: Collegiate, Club, Unattached. No high school athletes. Meet will be conducted according to NCAA Track & Field Rules.
- ENTRIES:** All entries are to completed on-line at www.flashresults.com/
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Monday, March 31st, 2008.
- ENTRY FEE:** All entry fees are due at PACKET PICK-UP, located in the President’s Box of Wallace Wade stadium \$325.00 for each men’s team, \$325.00 for each women’s team. \$10.00 extra for each entry beyond three per team in any single event, to be charged up front regardless of whether the athlete actually competes, \$25.00 FOR EACH OPEN ENTRY. Please make checks payable to Duke University.
- CUT OFF INFO:** Wednesday, April 2nd by 3:00pm, all cut off times to make seeded sections will be posted on the Duke Invitational web site at www.flashresults.com/
- AMENITIES:** Dressing and shower facilities will not be provided. No supplies will be provided by host school. Arrange to have your team manager secure your valuables. There will be a concession and T-Shirt sales.
- AWARDS:** T-shirts will be awarded to the champions in all events but must be claimed at the meet site. You can pick-up awards in the President's Box of Wallace Wade Stadium (top of the stands over looking 50-yard line). No awards will be mailed.
- RESULTS:** All results will be posted at www.flashresults.com/duke

- PACKET PICKUP:** Will be open from 11:00am - 6:00pm on Friday and 8:00am - 4:00pm on Saturday in the President's Box of Wallace Wade Stadium (top of the stands over looking 50 yard line).
- FIELD EVENTS:** High Jump & Pole Vault: We will contest two pits simultaneously with a seeded and unseeded section. In all other field events, seeded flights will compete first (trials & finals) with unseeded sections to follow. Please note that only a limited number of entries will be accepted in each field event: Top 40 entries in throwing events and Top 30 entries in all other field events.
- MEASUREMENTS:** One legal attempt will be measured for each athlete. Subsequent attempts must meet minimum standard.
- START/ENTRY LISTS:** Sections will be drawn up in the following events: all field events, seeded 800m – 1,500m – 3,000m – Steeplechase – 5,000m – 10,000m, and the 4 x 400m. All other sections will be determined after check-in. **IT IS VERY IMPORTANT** that athletes check in **AT LEAST 30min** before their **SCHEDULED** event start time, otherwise they will be scratched.
